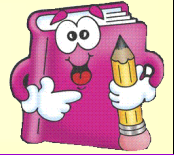

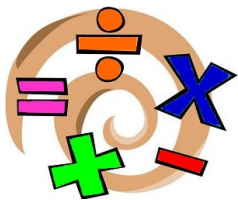
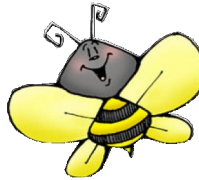


## Classroom Code of Conduct
